

Penrhyn Castle, North Wales Damp Proofing a Stunning 19th Century Castle

The Project

This enormous 19th Century Castle in Snowdonia, North Wales is in neo-Norman style, and is one of the most admired of the numerous mock castles built in the United Kingdom in the 19th Century. A former garage, originally the Castle brewery, was being transformed into a new courtyard cafe. The brickwork was very affected by penetrating damp ingress and structurally degraded, and a damp proofing solution was required which would be acceptable for use in this historic building.

The Solution

As the <u>National Trust</u> wanted to retain the appearance in keeping with the original lime plasterwork, <u>Newton 805 Newlath</u> damp proof membrane was recommended. Finished with plastered univeral one coat plaster, the membrane would provide a strong, dry and authentic looking wall finish.

805 Newlath is ideal for treating damp in listed and historic buildings and has been used on projects including the Houses of Parliament and Windsor Castle.

Acting as a physical barrier between the wall and finish, the membrane is fixed internally to the affected areas, allowing the walls to breathe and helping damp completely dry out.

The Result

After the installation of Newton 805 Newlath and the accompanying plaster finish, the walls retained the undulating aesthetic and the new finishes are quaranteed to be protected from penetrating damp.

The treatment is reversible, so if required in future, the wall can be returned to its original state.

Newton 805 Newlath is a composite damp-proofing membrane comprising of high density polypropylene membrane with a polythene mesh heat welded during the manufacturing process to the surface of one side.

This meshed surface creates a mechanical key to allow the membrane to be plastered, rendered or to receive dot & dab plasterboard.
